which of those men were a good neighbor to the injured fellow. The answer, of course, was the Samaritan, who helped him.

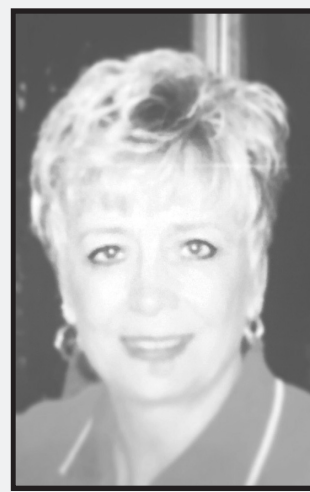
"Then said Jesus, Go, and do likewise" (Luke 10:37).
