I don't know how long he kept the agreement, but after awhile he sent to Egypt and asked Pharaoh for help. Thinking that with the help of Egypt he would defeat Babylon he moved ahead with his plans without thinking of God and the oath he had made. Any time a person goes ahead with his plans, or wants, without seeking God's counsel he is looking for trouble. God had allowed the Babylonians to conquer Jerusalem because of their sins. In fact Zedekiah made the punishment worse by his refusal to listen to Jeremiah. **2 Chronicles 36:11-13**, "Zedekiah was one and twenty years old when he began to reign, and reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. And he did that which was evil in the sight of the Lord his God, and humbled not himself before Jeremiah the prophet speaking from the mouth of the Lord. And he also rebelled against king Nebuchadnezzar, who had made him swear by God: but he stiffened his be in submission to him. God hates lies and those who tell them. In breaking his word Zedekiah brought shame on the Lord and gave the ungodly the impression that God's people were no better than the idol worshippers.

We may make mistakes for we are human, that is not the same as doing something wrong on purpose. Zedekiah broke his oath knowing exactly what he was doing. He was defeated and the last thing that he saw was his sons being killed in front of him, and then they blinded him. He was carried captive to Babylon and died there. 
