Is the Old Testament to be Kept Today?

Just about any time one turns on your TV, we will hear preachers preach from some text of the Old Testament and proceed to use them as if they were to be used for us today. What does the Bible say?

First of all, in Romans 15:4, it says, "For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope."

(continue reading 32-35) Verses 36-38 - "Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God? ³⁷If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not. ³⁸But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him.

John 8:42-45 - "Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me. 43Why do ye not understand my speech? even because ye cannot hear my word. 44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. 45 And because I tell you the truth, ye believe me not.'

I urge you, every one of you, to read the Bible and search for yourself. Don't just take anyone's word. That is what the Bible says!
