### Kentucky Chautauqua presents Daniel Boone: The First Kentuckian

The Estill County Historical Society & Genealogical Society and the Mountain Mushroom Festival together with Kentucky Chautauqua, will present Daniel Boone: The First Kentuckian at the Grandstand on Saturday, April 28 at 11:15 a.m.

By the time of his death, Daniel Boone (1754-1820) had become a legend, and so he remains. But much of what Americans think they know about this great frontiersman is off the mark. Neither a backwoods bumpkin nor an epic slayer of Indians (and he never wore a coonskin cap). Boone was an intrepid explorer and natural leader whose actual exploits easily justify his larger than life reputation.

Boone played a crucial role in the exploration and settlement of Kentucky and the American west. He first began to seriously explore Kentucky in 1769, and in 1775 led the expedition that founded Boonesboro in present-day Madison County. Some of his most-famous exploits soon followed the rescue of his daughter from Indian kidnappers; his own escape from captivity to warn Fort Boonesborough.

## Market Contest Rules

1. Bring only fresh mushrooms to the festival for sale: Frozen mushrooms will not be accepted. Mushrooms with dirt or roots will not be accepted. Mushrooms soaked in water will not be weighed. Only Mushrooms of *Morchella elata* (Black Morel), *M. esculenta* (Yellow Morel), and *M. semilibera* (Half-Free) varieties will be accepted. All other varieties will get identified and noted.
2. Market Volunteers will Record: a. Name, b. address, c. phone or message number, d. total weight of bulk or length and girth of largest (*Morchella*) mushroom.
3. Market Volunteers will measure and document net weight of bulk mushrooms (*Morchella*) brought in by each seller.
4. Market Volunteers will measure and document largest mushroom (edible morel only) in length plus girth.
5. All totals (weight and / or size) must be logged in at the Market by the 4 p.m. Saturday deadline, to be entered into the contest.
6. Market Volunteers will not handle any money. All sales will be conducted only between the buyer and seller.
7. Photo documentation of (weight / size) winners will take place immediately after the contest.
8. Market Volunteers will write down all important comments that improve the Mushroom Market.
9. No person except booth volunteers will be allowed in the booth.

## Vote Donnie Watson Estill County Judge/Executive

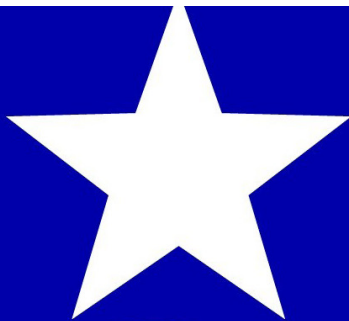

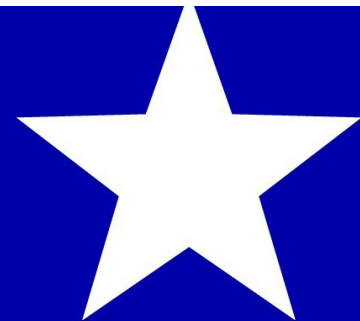
