Why are we ashamed to repent; to ask God's forgiveness, to let Him cleanse us again? I guess it could be from fear, or pride; even the assumption that others will know of our sins.

Maybe being ashamed is enough to let us know we need to repent of the things we do wrong. **2 Chronicles 7:14** - "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." This is a promise from God, to us everyone. We should be glad for His promises to us, not fight against it.

James 2:9-10 - "But if ye have respect to persons, ye commit sin, and are convinced of the law as transgressors. For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all." (They are no bigger sins than other sins. In God's eyes, Sin is Sin.) **1 John 2:1-4** - "My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father; Jesus Christ the righteous: 2And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only; but also for the sins of the whole world. 3And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. 4He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him."

1 John 2:28-29 - "And now, little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming. 29If ye know that he is righteous, ye know that every one that doeth righteousness is born of him." When we recognize our need for His forgiveness of the sins we commit, and repent, there lies the beginning of our rescue and salvation. **Psalm 3:8** - "Salvation belongeth unto the LORD: thy blessing is upon thy people. Selah"

2 Peter 2:14-20 - "Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children: 15Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; 16But was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet. 17These are wells without water; clouds that are carried with a tempest; to whom the mist of darkness is reserved for ever. 18For when they speak great swelling words of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, through much wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error. 19While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage. 20For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning."

These scriptures point out how easily we can get to the place of unrighteousness and fall prey to the point of no repentance where we allow our own madness of sins to rule us, and refuse to admit our own mistakes and become consumed with our own desires, never realizing and receiving the gift of repentance God so freely gives us.

"This is going to hurt me more than it does you," said the father to his young son as he took him from the family room for interrupting our conversation. I'd heard that statement many times and always wondered what the parent wanted the child to understand when it was used. If it was used to redirect a child's behavior and teach him or her an important lesson about life, why not say so. That's what the author of Psalm 94 meant when he wrote, "If God disciplines you, consider yourself blessed" or "full of blessings!"

To discipline means "to teach." Discipline is not punishment as we understand it - though it may involve suffering and loss, disappoint-

ment and feelings of rejection. When God disciplines us, it is His method to bring us back to live within His commandments and laws and the teachings of Jesus. It is about "getting our attention" when we are overcome by temptation and fall into sin. It's about being confronted by God when He corrects us for allowing the "things or the people or the attractions of this world" to take His place. It is about worshiping those things rather than the Creator of those "things."

One of the blessings of discipline is that it has long term benefits for the Christian. If in His mercy He brings loss or suffering to teach us a lesson today, and if we are willing to learn from the loss or suffering when it happens, we will be spared from greater losses or more suffering in the future - and bring more honor to Him.

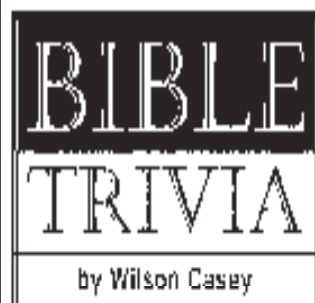
