Engineers face Powell County in district finals

The Estill County Engineers will be facing the Powell County Pirates tonight, Wednesday, May 23, 2018, at Danny Wood Field in Irvine in the 56th District championship. The teams are nearly equal on paper with each having 17 wins and a 6-1 district record.

Powell County has lost 12 times while the Engineers have lost 15. The two teams split games in regular season but the Pirates won 10-4 over Estill and the Engineers only won by one run 7-6, giving Powell the

advantage in winning the regular season district title.

Estill won easily in their opener on Monday night against the Lee County Bobcats, 11-1 in five innings.

Meanwhile, the Pirates blew out the Owsley County Owls, 26-0, also in five innings.

Regardless of the outcome on Wednesday night, both teams will be headed to the 14th Region Tournament next week.
