What is a Revival?

What is the definition of revival? "To make to live again," or "to have a new beginning or life;" or Biblically speaking, "to restore one to a new manner of life."

This Wednesday evening we have a capable preacher coming our way with just this in mind. We hope you may show an interest in attending there, three meetings designed to inform, raise awareness, and to sound the alarm concerning the judgment to come. Each of these meetings will begin promptly at 7:00 p.m.

Many times people will make the announcement that, 'we are going to have a revival.' Now, I do not wish to have a smug attitude, but frankly, they do not know if they will have a revival or not. It is important to most churches to have separate meetings from the normal schedule because this will be an extra effort; hopefully, put forward by the whole congregation to grab the attention of the unsaved, relaxed in the world, sinner, whom maybe will only attend once or more a year. Jesus said of the Jews before their end came in AD 70, "And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold."
