

Ladies Win Over Montgomery Co.

The Estill County Lady Engineers saw their season record go to 14-10 with a rout of Montgomery County on Monday night. The win would break a five game losing streak after taking on some of the best teams in the state this past week. The Lady En-

gineers bats would be hot in this one as they rapped out twelve hits in the five inning affair. The offense would be led by seniors Wood, Covey and Wiseman as they collected six hits and drove in ten runs on the night. T. Duechle would add two hits and an RBI. M. Hale, K. Riddell, A. Sparks, and E. Hardy

would all single knocks as well. Covey would be spot on from the mound giving up only three hits and striking out seven.

Estill's offense would be anemic through a three game stretch as they could only collect nine hits and two runs while facing the toughest pitching all year. Estill would be shutout in

losses to Boyle County, 11-0, and Garrard County, 3-0, and put up two runs in a loss to East Jessamine, 10-2. The Estill bats would start to wake up as they travelled to Morehead for the Rowan County Triangle. Estill would drop the opener to Rowan in eight innings, 5-4. L. Wood and M. Hale would both collect three hits and K. Riddell would drive in three with a homer and a double. Covey would only give up 2 earned runs and strike out 6 in the loss. Estill's late game rally would fall short

as they dropped the second game to Lawrence County, 4-3. K. Riddell would go yard in this game as well and Hale would collect two more hits.

The Lady Engineers will play their last week of regular season play this week as they have their eye on District Tournament action.
