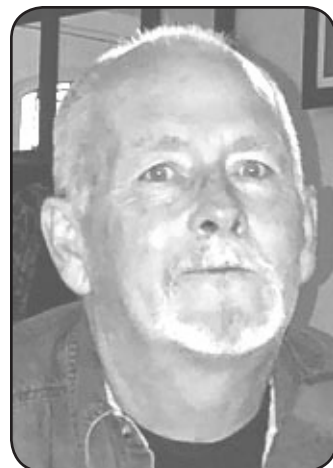
## Darrell Stamper, 57
