2018 Estill County Youth Salute Winners

830 high school juniors from 55 high schools in Central Kentucky, including 11 from Estill County High School, are being recognized in this year's "Youth Salute". The 38th Annual Awards Ceremony was held in their honor on Sunday, May 6th, at Eastern Kentucky University.

A top Youth Leader was named for each high school in attendance, as well as "Youth Leaders of the Year." Six all-expense paid trips to the National Leadership Workshop in St. Louis were announced along with \$80,000 in scholarships and other awards. Asbury University, Eastern Kentucky University, Georgetown College and Transylvania University each provided \$20,000 in scholarships. Private businesses provided an additional \$10,000 in scholarships and other awards. A leadership seminar presented by Eastern Kentucky University was held for all the students the same day as the awards ceremony.

Estill County student Kiely Montgomery Flynn was named as the top ECHS Youth Leader and was also named as one of five students to receive a \$4,000 scholarship from Asbury University.

The Central Kentucky Council on Youth Leadership was formed in 1980 to conduct the "Youth Salute" in nearby counties in cooperation with the National Council on Youth Leadership, a non-profit organization. Students were nominated by teachers, guidance counselors and principals for this year's "Youth Salute". In order to qualify, the student had to be a junior (senior class of 2019), have a 3.0 G.P.A. or better and have held at least two (2) leadership roles to which they were chosen by their peers or an adult leader within the past two years in school, religious or community sponsored
