The 2018 Edition of the Estill County Lady Engineers Softball Team wrote their last chapter this past week at the Kentucky Fastpitch State Tournament in Owensboro. The Lady Engineers were defeated in both of their games as they took on two of the top 20 teams in the state.

As was the case through the 14th Region Tournament, the Estill bats were slow to start but in this case, they failed to come through in the later innings.

Estill would match zeroes with Boyle County through the first few innings in the opening game but Boyle's bats would warm up later on and take down Estill 9-0.

The second game would feature a matchup with #8 Apollo and once again, the Ladies would hold their own by only trailing 2-0 going into the fifth inning.

But after two 10-minute and one 30-minute heat delays, the Lady Engineers could not muster up any offense and fell by the score of 6-0.

With the loss, the Lady Engineers would end their season with a 20-14 record, a thirteenth consecutive 56th District Title, and a 14th Re-

gion Championship for the tenth time.

The four seniors formed the nucleus of this team and led by example both on and off the field. They proclaimed after last year's Regional loss that they would bring the 14th Region Title back home, mission accomplished!! 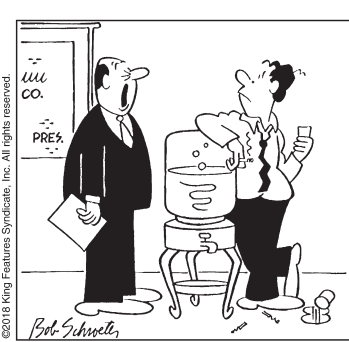
- One patient was given a wig and other non-wig head coverings.

- One patient was supplied

with a Personal Health Manager, which is an organizational binder for those going through treatment, specific to their type of cancer.

- Three referrals were given to other resources to help patients through treatment through our Cancer Resource Connection which is a database of all national and local resources that a patient might be able to utilize or find helpful while going through treatment.
