Graveside services were conducted Saturday, June 9, 3:00 p.m., at the Marcum Cemetery.

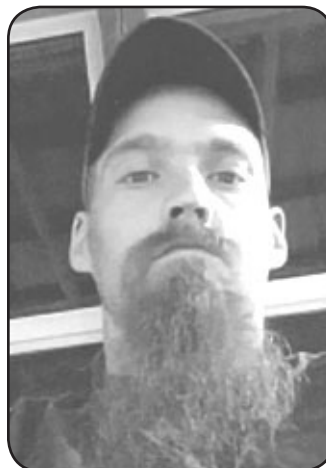
