Are you worshipping under the Law of Moses?

There are many folks right today in their services that inadvertently, or maybe intentionally, are attempting to offer unto the Lord worship that is not authorized by the Scriptures. In Matthew 19:1-10, our Lord has given unto Peter, James and John a preview of the Heavenly body by being transfigured before them. And, at the same time, there appeared also Moses and Elijah, talking with him. Notice that the Apostles thought it to be good if all three remained with them, for they proposed to build them three dwellings. But God the Father intervened, saying, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." (1 Peter 1:17) So, their proposal was not in the will of the Father. By use of the words, he was excluding the Law of Moses and the supernatural power of the prophets, by saying, to hear "his Only Son," at this time.

So, we may easily see that the Law of Moses and the teachings of the rest of the Old Testament had its fulfilling time before Jesus came preaching the Gospel of forgiveness and salvation which the Law did not do. So, today, men are not and will not be saved by using the Old Testament Law. Notice carefully, Romans 8:1-4, "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit."

Jesus said clearly in John 6:36, "It is the spirit that quickeneth (makes alive); the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life." Then in Galatians 2:16, Paul wrote, "Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified." (declared righteous)

So, today, some in worship might say, 'I know that we are not living under the Law,' but they will use unscriptural names to identify themselves instead. Then, they will offer attempted praise to God by playing musical instruments, instead of singing with the mouth alone.
