

Lady Engineers are going to the state with tenth 14th title

The Estill County Lady Engineers Softball Team secured their spot in yet another State Tournament with a 14th Region Championship this past Saturday.

The Lady Engineers would easily handle the Lady Commodores of Perry County Central by the score of 7-1. Preseason predictions had these two teams as the best in the 14th Region and sure to meet in the finals. Estill would carry some confidence in this one after handling Perry Central earlier in the season in a 11-1 mercy rule contest.

Hoping to end their early offensive woes, the Ladies wasted no time getting on the board in this one.

Lindsey Wood would lead off the bottom of the first with a single and a stolen base and Kaylee Covey would ground back to the pitcher for what would seem an easy play, but the Perry Central pitcher would over-

throw her first baseman allowing Wood to score from second.

Sarah Wiseman would then lace a single to center to bring in Rayleigh Jones from second to give Estill a 2-0 lead.

The scoring was not finished for Estill as Mia Hale singled, followed by a Kaylee Riddell walk.

A wild pitch would advance both runners and Taylor Duechle would ground to third that forced another bad throw and plated two more for the Lady Engineers.

Covey would be in total control on the mound allowing only a third inning solo home run for Perry's lone run. The fifth inning would see Estill's offense turn on again as Covey and Wiseman led off the inning with back to back singles. Hale would reach on a fielders choice and after Riddell's sac. fly brought in a run and advanced the runners, Alyssa Sparks would sharply single in two more to give Estill a

comfortable 7-1 lead.

Covey would continue to dominate the Perry lineup and a called third strike was a fitting end as Estill County would claim their tenth 14th Region Championship in the last thirteen years and book their trip to Owensboro again.

Four Lady Engineers would grab All Region Tournament honors: Lindsey Wood, Sarah Wiseman, Taylor Duechle and Kaylee Covey (MVP).

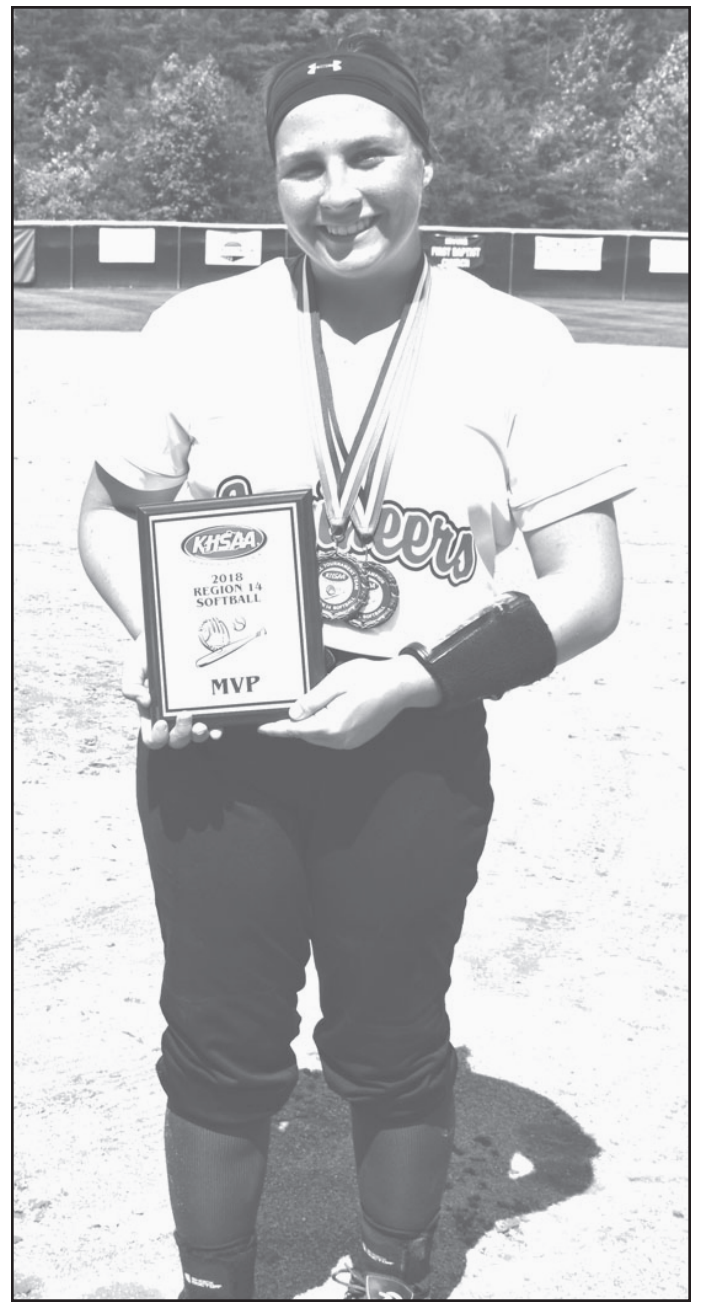
Estill 7 - Wolfe County 0

the seventh. A fourth inning RBI single from T. Duechle would give Estill a 1-0 lead and RBI singles by Wiseman and Duechle in the fifth would give the Ladies some breathing room. A four run sixth led by Wiseman's two run single, a Riddell triple and a RBI groundout by Sparks would put this one in the bag.
