Thrips are Abundant This Year



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According to UK Entomologist Ric Bessin, there have been several reports of high thrips populations attacking crops and bothering homeowners alike this spring. Despite their tiny size, various thrips species are serious direct pests in greenhouses/ high tunnels as well. Thrips are also vectors of Tosopviruses, such as tomato spotted wilt virus. Gardeners and commercial growers are encouraged to monitor for thrips, along with symptoms of the viruses they might transmit. Pay particular attention to susceptible crops, such as tomatoes and peppers grown in high tunnels, as well as these same crops and other vegetable crops in production fields.

Most adult thrips are elongate, slender, minute (less than 1/20 inch long), and have long fringes on of their long, narrow wings.



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
