# Crucify Him, Crucify Him!

In **Matthew 27:22-23**, Palate asked, "What shall I do then with Jesus which is called Christ?" They all said unto him, "Let him be crucified." Then the governor asked, "Why, what evil hath he done?" But, they cried out the more, "Let him be crucified."

Seeing then that nothing less would pacify the Jews, he gave unto their desires and delivered Jesus to die on the cross.

My question is: Why did these people hate the Lord so badly? Even after proving that the was the Messiah, sent from God, so long awaited for to come; why then did they change their minds when he did come?

I believe that the answer is very clear, being fueled by the religious leaders who despised Jesus because He denounced their hypocrisy and self-made tradition. He exposed them for what they really were, lovers of power, lovers of the praises of men, lovers of money, and desiring to be called a father.

Notice in **Matthew 23**, just a few days before his arrest, our Lord made a public exposure of evil traditional lifestyles of the Pharisees and Scribes and cast woe after woe upon them, and then said in **verses 32-32**, "Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers. Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?"

Then, after two days to come for the Feast of the Passover, they made plans to covertly arrest and to kill him (**Matthew 26:1-4**).

How did they arrive at this point in time?

Notice that our Lord revealed himself by doing many miracles (**John 2:23**). Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews, picked up very quickly that Jesus was one sent from God because of the miracles that he did (**John 3:2**). Then again in **John 7:25-31**, because of

the miracles and the teachings (**in verse 25**), some of them in Jerusalem said, "Is not this he, whom they seek to kill?" Then again they said, "he speaketh boldly, and they say nothing unto him. Do the rulers know indeed that this is the very Christ?" (**verse 26**) Then, after Jesus declared plainly that they knew him and that God had sent him; many of the people believed on him and said, "When Christ cometh, will he do more miracles than these which this man hath done?" (**verse 30**)

Still, the evil, religious leaders awaited their chance to begin the assault on him. So, after all the proof of being the Messiah, did they despise him?

It was because he rejected their self-imposed beliefs called here the traditions of the elders (**Matthew 15:1-9**) They thought it a terrible thing that the disciples of Jesus did not keep the traditions of the elders by not washing their hands before eating, thereby elevating their personal beliefs before the commandment of God. He denounced them for their hypocrisy saying, ye also transgress the commandment of God by not honoring your father and mother. Thereby in **verse 6**, saying, "ye made the commandment of God of none effect by your tradition."

Then in **Mark 7:1-9**, Jesus said of the tradition keeping Jews (**verse 6-7**) "This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me. Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men." In **verse 9**, "Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition."

Friend, our county and nation is filled up with religious traditions that cannot, and will never, save one soul. There are hundreds, even thousands, of religious traditions that if continued will doom souls to a fiery death some day. Examine the word for truth. Question our religious leaders to prove what they are asking you to accept. This we do all the time in the Lord's church. So, we invite you to attend with us, ask questions, believe and follow only the truth. Can we be more fair that this?
