An example box may contain 2 cereals, 2 cans of fruit, 4 cans of vegetables, peanut butter, cheese, 24 ounces of meat, juice and pasta or rice.

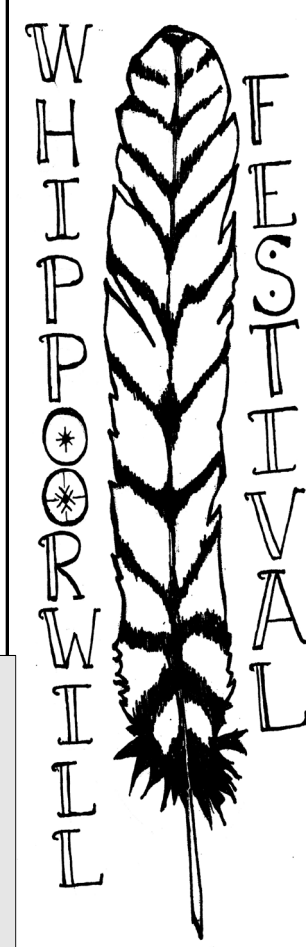
