This manner of life is given us in You can do this by hearing his commands <u>to believe</u> the book called "the Bible." It declares that through obedience to Jesus we can be free from the slavery of sin and death. In John 8:31-21, Jesus said to these Jews that believed and followed him, saying *"If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples"* indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

Some might say, well Preacher, 'I am already free so why should I listen to what you have to say?" So, listen to what the Bible says in **Romans 6:16**,

"Know ve not, that to whom ve vield vourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?"

Notice some isolated verses in Romans. In chapter 8, verse 6, where it says, "to be carnally minded (unsaved) is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace." Notice Romans 6:20, "For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from *righteousness.*" Then, at the close of the chapter, Paul says, "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."
