Spiritual Discipline

In 1 Corinthians 9:24-27, "Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain. And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we (Christians) an incorruptible."

"I therefore (personal) so run, not as uncertainly; so fight I, not as one that beateth the air: But I keep (discipline) under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway (or a reject)."

The Apostle Paul is giving unto us a great piece of much needed advice; especially since the devil is constantly making an attempt to get us to live careless, reckless, and carefree lifestyles. Disciplining one's body is much like an athlete when he wants to excel in his quest to master some difficult physical feat. But Paul takes this thought and relates to us that as a Christian seeking the prize of Heaven, we must put forth the same type of effort to be successful in obtaining our Heavenly home. Here he also stresses the fact that as a faithful, disciplined Christian, that we are not running this race as one that has uncertain outcome, but as one that will obtain a crown of life for sure. In **Revelations 2:10**, John wrote to the Christians of Smyrna, saying, "be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life."

So then, if people will make the choice to live a life that is governed by the Bible, they can also inherit the crown. Now our question should be

very clear, "What is it to bring one's body into subjection?" First, in **Romans 8:7-8**, Paul also says, "Because the carnal (bitter, hostile) mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. So then they that are in the flesh (unsaved) cannot please God."

So, the first thing to live a life of Christian discipline is to get one's mind focused upon the rules of life given to us in God's rule book, the Bible. Why is this so important? Because when we stand before Jesus in judgment, the Bible will be the only book wherein all of us living today will be judged from its content. **Revelations 20:11-13**, "And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works."


So today, if you have not prepared your body to live a disciplined life according to God's rule book, when are you going to start doing so? **Hebrews 9:27** says, "And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:" Why won't you familiarize yourself with the Bible, hear Jesus, obey Jesus, stop following the ways of this sinful world that will destroy you.

In closing, **Romans 8:13**, says "For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify (put to death) the deeds of the body, ye shall live."

So, stop listening to the devil. He offers you nothing but pain, suffering in the end. Seek the peace you so desperately need. Jesus can give it to you, if you will obey him.
