Wilma was preceded in death by her brothers: Leonard, Lenual, Glendene and Shirley Berger; and her sister, Alieve Berger.

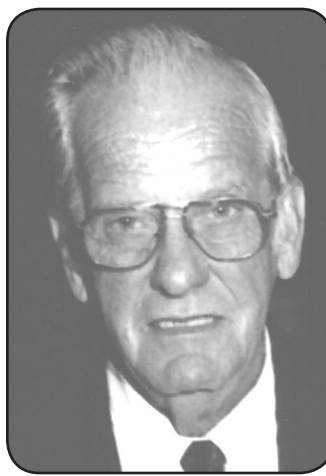
Survivors other than her husband of 63 years, Robert, include her daughter, Gloria Flinchum; her son, Greg Flinchum; her
