We here at the Estill County Public Library have so many great programs to offer to the community that we would like to write a little bit more about those each week to keep you all up-to-date on happenings that occurred recently and happenings that are about to occur!

So to start off, for our adults, we have just recently restarted our Adult Book Club after taking the summertime off. It meets the first Tuesday of each month at 1:30 p.m. The first meeting happened on Tuesday, August 7th and the next meeting will be taking place on Tuesday, September 4th. Although there has already been one meeting, don't be afraid to jump right in - new members are welcome and encouraged to join anytime!
