As people in general, many are taking risks nearly every day. Varied are the ways in which one can do this. For instance, crossing the street in an unmarked place, driving too fast, or using a cell phone while driving. Wall Street does this every day in the stock market.

People even take risks involving their health; eating too much junk food, smoking tobacco and marijuana, and sadly, ingesting those deadly opioids. Melissa Patrick of Kentucky Health News wrote a very informing article printed in The Estill County Tribune just this past week concerning the dangers of all those combined drugs.

Still, many risk their health and lives by continuing to use them. Only turning to Christ will ever bring an ending to this blight upon our country.

But today, I want to suggest a type of person who may be the greatest risk taker, and this is a Gospel Preacher who preaches the plain truth from the Bible only, and upon any subject. All the Book of Acts is filled with such men. They hazarded their lives by telling it as Jesus taught them; many times beaten, jailed, threatened with death and being stoned. So, in closing, I ask, what about you, Dear Friend, does the Word of the Lord offend you? Our Lord pronounces blessings upon all who are not offended by the truth. Just take notice of the verse spoken by our Lord himself, in Matthew 11:6, "And blessed is he, whosoever shall not be offended in me."

It has never been my intention of offending anyone while attempting to preach. Still, I know there has been and will continue to be, some offended in the future, simply because the teachings of the Lord are offensive to all who will not obey the truth. How sad this is!
