# The Sin of Alcoholism

The wisest man besides our Lord Jesus was Solomon, the great king of Israel. He penned these words for all time. **Proverbs 23:29-34**, "Who hath woe? who hath sorrow? who hath contentions? who hath babbling? who hath wounds without cause? who hath redness of eyes?" Then he proceeds to give us the answers, "They that tarry long at the wine; they that go to seek mixed wine."

So, today, we can see in the advertisements of those that deal in such things; there is beer, whiskey, vodka, even moonshine, all of these are intoxicants that rob any person of their human faculties and soundness of mind.

So, why would any sound and reasonable person indulge by taking into their bodies this terrible drink? I believe I know the answer. It is under the influence of the devil that they do so, seeking, they say, a good time. Drink all you can in as a short amount of time you have and then go out behind a tree and throw it all up. Man, what a time!

There is no doubt some are saying to themselves at this time, does not the Bible say, "use a little wine for thy stomach's sake and thine often infirmities." (**1 Timothy 5:23**) So, there is no doubt that in those days, wine was used in some manner as modern-day medicines are today, but all the alcohol used in today's medicines is only there to prevent the real medicine from spoiling. So, I do not have to run down to the local whiskey store to medicate myself as many attempt to do.

Look at the continuation of Solomon's advice in

**Verses 31-35**, "Look not thou upon the wine when it is red (or at the highest volume of intoxicants), when it giveth his colour in the cup, when it moveth itself aright" (fully fermented), when it will make you drunk, altering your natural abilities, "At the last it biteth like a serpent, and stingeth like an adder." Thereby being intoxicated causes anyone not to act in a normal way, Saying, "thine eyes shall behold strange women, and thine heart shall utter perverse things."

Alcoholism is one of the reasons for so many divorces and deserted children; even death upon our highways. The latest statistics say 65% of all traffic deaths are alcohol-related.

**Alcohol robs one of his common senses.** "Yea, thou shalt be as he that lieth down in the midst of the sea, or as he that lieth upon the top of a mast." Then after a night of boozing it up, and fighting usually occurs, "They have stricken me, shalt thou say, and I was not sick; they have beaten me, and I felt it not: when shall I awake? I will seek it yet again."

And, so goes the life of one who is a drinker of alcohol. **Some will no doubt say**, 'Well, it is my business. I will have my drink whether some like it or not.' And so it is, but know this, our Lord has already said in I Corinthians 6:9-10, that **no drunkards shall inherit the Kingdom of God**. Also, in Galatians 5:21, the same things are written also.

So, the next time you are tempted to enter into either one of the two whiskey stores in our small town, which I believe is a blight upon our community, remember that one day you will be called into an accounting for it, "make no mistake about it." II Corinthians guarantees your appearance in that day. **Just think, and maybe you will not drink!**

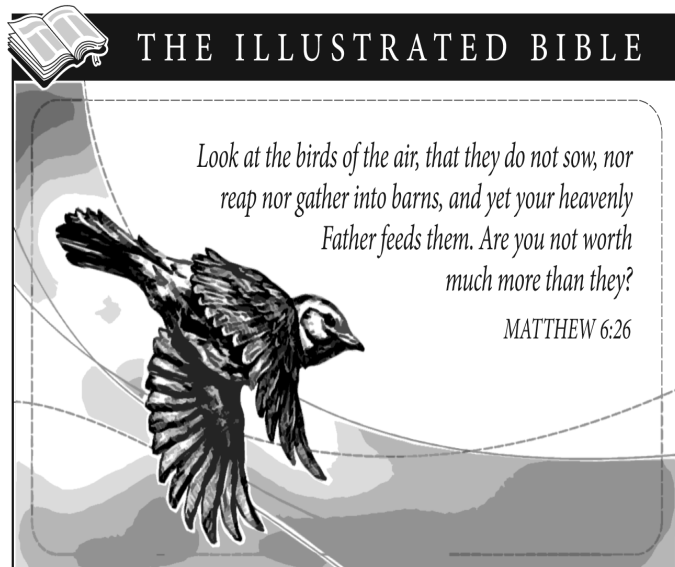
