deer season opened on Saturday, September 1, a number of new regulations took harvest up to four deer. place.

• The modern gun deer season has been lengthened in Zones 3 and 4 and will now be 16 days across all zones, opening Nov. 10 and continuing through Nov. 25, 2018.

The statewide and youth deer permits now allow for the harvest of up to four deer. While the harvest allotment for statewide and muzzleloader season. youth deer permits has inremains in place statewide.

• The following counties have changed from Zone 2 to Zone 1: Union, Henderson, McLean, Muhlenberg, Todd, Mercer, Mason and Hart.

• The following counties Dec. 29-30, 2018. have changed from Zone 3 to Zone 2: Warren, Allen, Monroe, Barren, Metcalfe, Adair, Edmonson, Butler, Breckinridge, Meade, Hancock, Da-Boyle, Madison, Clark, Montgomery and Bath.

Each county across the state is assigned to one of four deer zones. Bag limits are zone specific. Hunters can harvest up to the zone bag fall hunting and trapping limit in each zone but would need an additional deer permit to take more than four and provides information deer statewide.



Kentucky Ginseng Program

Ginseng Program Summary

- ⇒ Ginseng harvest season is from September 1 - December 1, each calendar year
- ⇒ Buying season for green ginseng starts September 1 each calendar year
- ⇒ Buying season for dry ginseng is from September 15 - March 31 each calendar year
- Dealer licenses are valid annually from September 1 - August 31 and cost \$75.00 for Kentucky residents and \$150.00 for non-residents.
- ⇒ Harvesters can declare their ginseng as wild, wild simulated, woodsgrown or cultivated.
- ⇒ All fees collected are deposited specifically for the ginseng program.

Ginseng Age

The minimum age of harvest by law is 5 years and 3 prongs. However, the market for ginseng prefers roots 10 years old and older.

Underage Root

Not only is underage root illegal to harvest, it's really not worth anything. In this picture are 16 young roots harvested before maturity. These 16 roots shown below weigh less than ONE whole ginseng root of marketable age. If young plants come up when digging a larger root, plant them back into the same spot and leave them for your children and grandchildren to harvest.

GOOD STEWARDSHIP CHECKLIST When harvesting American Ginseng, make sure you follow all of these good stewardship practices.

- ☐ Get permission to harvest.
- ☐ Only harvest plants that have 3 prongs or are at least 5 years of age.
- □ Only dig plants with red berries
- ☐ Plant berries within fifty feet of where you dug the root with your finger in 3/4 to 1 inch of soil.
- ☐ Leave some mature plants for the future.
- ☐ If young plants come up when digging a larger root, plant them back into the same spot.
