

# Estill boys golf wins over 20 teams at Morehead

The defending 2017 regional boys golf champions, the Estill County Engineers, won their third tournament this year at Eagle Trace in Rowan County.

Estill's boys had won previously at their home tournament this year where Estill players finished 1st, 2nd and 3rd, and won the Paintsville Tourney at the site of the 2018 regional tournament to be played in September. They also came in second place at Arlington.

The Rowan County Tournament had 20 teams including squads from Mont-

gomery and Clark counties and Lexington Catholic.

Estill's boys beat second place Montgomery County by nine strokes. The Engineers shot a very impressive 293 which is five over par. Two players shot 74 (Cobbe and Kade), another shot 72 (Napier), and one had 73 (Joe).

Cobbe Click had struggled all year with his golf game and "had been all over the place" until Saturday when he shot an impressive 74 with no double or triple bogies. He had ten pars, three bird-

ies and five bogies. Cobbe almost had a hole in one Saturday and scored his best score this year on an away course.

Cobbe is the son of Rebecca and Blain Click. "So proud of him, he kept trying and it finally paid off today," his mother wrote on Facebook. "He needed this great golf day today; so happy for him. Love u and proud of u Cobbe Click."

Estill's team is very young, Click, Isaac Napier and Andrew Elam are sophomores and they have one eighth grader, Kade Benton. Joe Benton is the only junior.

They are hoping to win the regional for a second year in a row and have a great chance of going back to the State this year in Bowling Green as regional champs for the second time this year.

Three boys golf players, Cobbe, Joe and Kade, were part of the Estill County Engineers basketball team that went to the state earlier this year, along with their coach, Ricky Joe Benton, who is an assistant basketball coach.
