In The Service of my Lord

In some hymn books, there is one song mentioned by the title of "In the Service of the King." I am all too much afraid that many people who may be presently, or even upon their death beds, hold to the idea that all you have to do in order to go to Heaven is 'to make a confession with our mouths that we believe in Jesus' and then assume that our future hopes are all firmly settled. **At this time, let me say**, that one can never go to be with the Lord and live in his Heaven unless we believe that Jesus is **the only Christ** and that for the sake of our salvation, it is required of us. Just as confessing him in public is required. **But, let me add**, that this is not the only steps one must take in order to secure his eternity with Christ.

A noted preacher once said, 'If all I had to preach from was John 3:16, this would be all I need to convert a person.' Let me say this, **John 3:16 is all truth, but it is not all of the truth.** The same Lord who spoke John 3:16 into existence also said that unless one repented of his past sins he would perish. He also spoke unto his plan of redemption which was **baptism for the remission of our sins** (See Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-16). Also, the plan was implemented by the Apostles in Acts 2:14-47 where they commanded the believers to be baptized for the putting away of their past sins.

One noted preacher is heard every week on worldwide television to say 'if you believe in Jesus and if you have prayed this little prayer with me, we believe that you have been born again.' This I believe, that **this noted speaker needs to dig a little**

deeper into the **Book of Knowledge to get the facts made clearer.** It behoves me to understand how one could make an attempt to convert people supposedly to Christ when he himself does not believe all the Holy Scriptures.

In **2 Timothy 3:16-17**, the Apostle who received his instructions straight from the Lord said, **"All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: ¹⁷That the man of God may be perfect (complete), thoroughly furnished unto all good works."** So then, if any man desires to be in service unto His King, what should be the first question? "What must I do Lord?" **So then**, service to our Lord, Master and King is more than making an assent of the mind, or praying a little prayer for entrance into Heaven, but **we must involve ourselves** in study of the Bible in order to fully understand our duty as a servant to our King. In **Luke 6:46**, Jesus clearly says, **"And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?"** Any job that I have ever had, I wanted to know what was required to do it and if an understanding was agreed upon; then, I went to work. It is no difference in the service of our Lord. Many men asked these questions in the Bible. For example, the rich young ruler (Mark 10:17), the believers in Acts 2:37, or Saul of Tarsus in Acts 9:6, the Ethiopian treasurer in Acts 8:36, the Philippian jailer in Acts 16, and so on, the list goes. **So, in closing**, let me say this, 'If your total involvement in the service of our King only involves church attendance once a week, then you are absent in your service for the rest of the week.

Remember this, Heaven is a reward for services rendered for the Lord. Read Revelation 22:12-14, it says that men will be rewarded accordingly as his work (service) shall be. And blessed are they who do his commandments. **Sincerely, Bob Casey, (1-859-369-4165), anytime.**
