Local Teen Club participates in first service project of the year



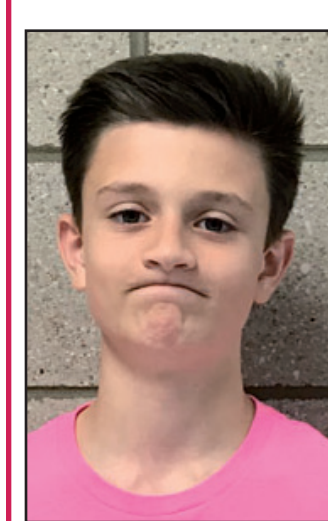

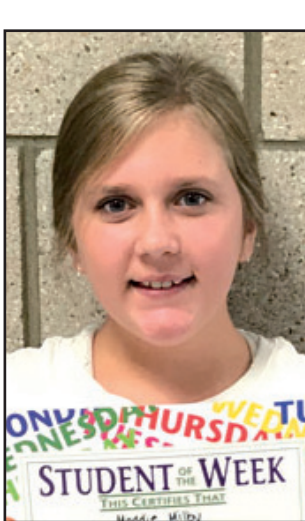


Estill Middle Students of the Week
