Thomas Gene Hughes, 83

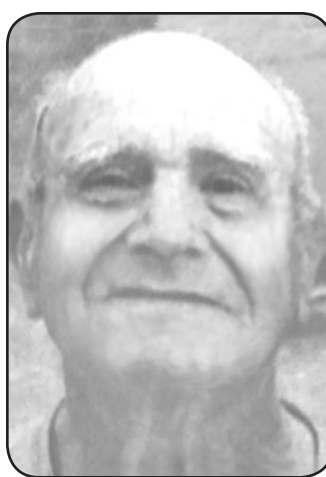
