

Estill Middle 7th & 8th Blow Out Madison

The Estill County Middle School basketball teams are doing quite well this season as the year comes to a close.

The 6th grade is coached by Trent Singleton and Josh England and are 20-1 after a blow out over Madison Middle last Thursday night. The 6th was also a winner in the 56th District Tournament against Lee, Owsley and Powell.

The 6th grade opened up 20-0, then led 27-6 at half time over a defenseless Madison Middle team. Casey Chaney and Levi Beckler each scored 13 in the run-out over the Madison team.

The 7th grade is coached by Seth Horn and were 18-3 after a win over Madison and

also won the 56th District Tournament. Chaney also played for the 7th grade and scored nine in the 46-16 7th grade win. Hayden Woolery scored 10 points to lead.

Estill's boys fell to Montgomery County, 52-58, won over Lee County in district

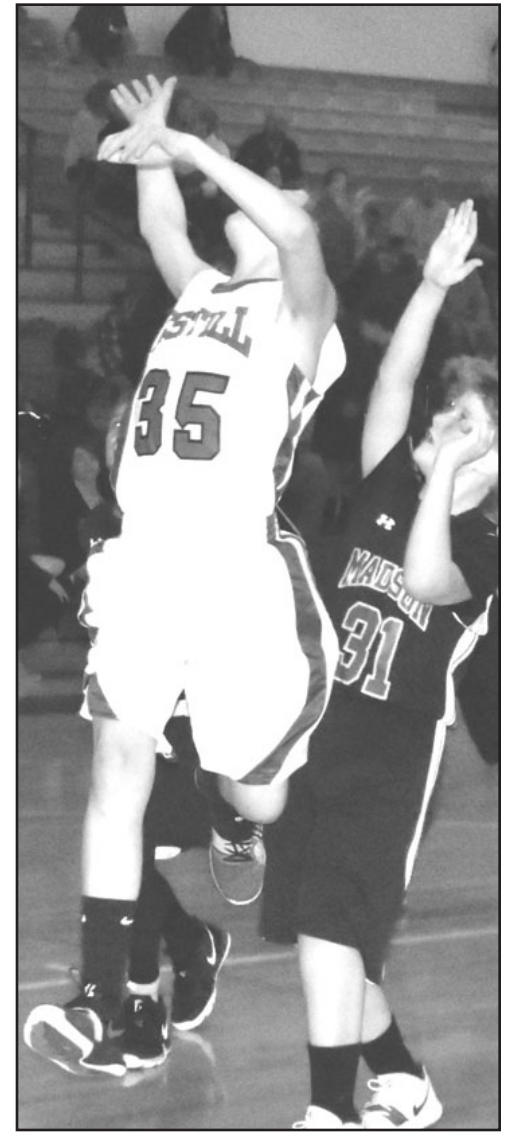
action, 76-54; then lost to regional contender Breathitt County, 85-72.
