He was preceded in death by his sister, Melissa Dawn Walters.

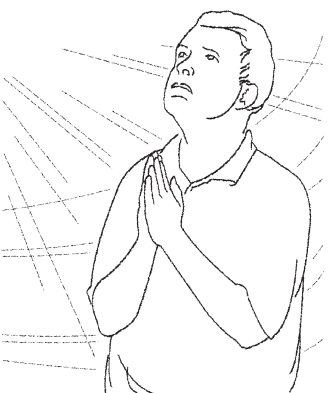
