host the 9th annual UK Equine Showcase, Friday & Saturday, January 24-25 at the Fayette County Extension office, 1140 Harry Sykes Way in Lexington. The event will highlight the university's equine

programs and relevant industry findings with an emphasis on the foal, from birth to weaning. The event will span two days: Friday, Jan. 24 from 12:30 to 5 p.m. with a networking happy hour following Friday's event and Saturday, Jan. 25, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. with lunch provided.

Topics for the showcase include epidemiology and diagnostics, infectious disease, immunology and parasitology, nutrition, musculoskeletal issues, genetics and economics.

"This is a unique and special outreach event. The purpose is to 'showcase' some of what is happening at the University of Kentucky in terms of scientific discovery and service efforts relevant to young foals," said James MacLeod, director of UK Ag Equine


