


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Bus Ride


As he does so, he notices Ma has tears streaming down her face. "Look," says the doctor, "There's no need to get upset about getting glasses."

Mayor Gross said that if the council agreed to it, they could transfer funds from the fire department equipment fund and the street department fund to the state aid fund and be able to pay the loan off.

He said this would avoid any late fees with the bank and once Price released the money it could be transferred back to the two line items within the budget that it was borrowed from.
