Watson Family will be the featured singers.

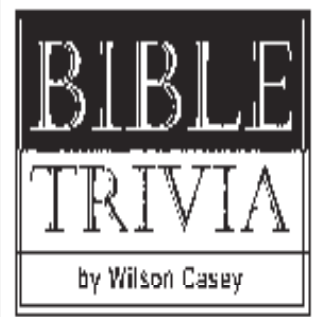

It is always wise to think before we talk and ask God to guide our words. And it is important to look to the Lord for insight before we leap into the unknown. It is certainly critical to pray before we proceed with any plan. If we ever fear we are failing it's time to fall on our knees and ask God to come to our rescue. ## Where can Jesus be found?

Before we begin, I once again wish to express our condolences to the family of Larry Lee Wolf, a brother in Christ who attended and was baptized by the Cornerstone Church some time ago. He was faithful in attendance until his bout with cancer prevented him from coming. But his sufferings are now forever behind him as he went into the comforts of the Lord (See Luke 16:19-25).

**Our question for today:**

Where can the Lord be found, where can we find the information needed to guide us there. I suggest that the Lord can be found in His Word. I recommend the reading of **Luke 4:18-19**, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord."

Yes, indeed, he can be found in his Word. In **John 14:6**, "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." If you are a seeker, just where ARE you looking?

Also suggest that the Lord can be found in a faithful church house where the Gospel is fully believed, taught, obeyed (See Matthew 18:20).

Then, the Lord can be found when as a Christian we seek him with our whole heart or mind. In **1 Peter 3:12**, "For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil." Also, **Luke 11:9** says, "And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you." Yes, the Christian has this precious access to God, only through Christ.

Then, I suggest that the Lord can be found when we submit ourselves to Biblical baptism, as a burial, immersion, covered; and for the purpose of remission of sins (Acts 2:38). Romans 6:3-7 informs us that we enter into Jesus as we "were baptized into his death?" This is when we contact his shed blood, raised to walk, cleansed, made whole, enter in the

newness of life. Aren't you glad?

Next, I also suggest that we can meet Jesus as he presides over his table at the weekly communion supper. Again, see Matthew 18:20 and Matthew 26:17-30; also **Luke 22:7-20**.

In **verse 19**, our Lord says, "this do in remembrance of me." Then in Acts 20:6-7, we see that the disciples of the Lord considered this our holy act by meeting upon the first day of the week to remember the sufferings of Jesus. Paul taught the church at Corinth. In 1st Corinthians 11:23-25, how often? Every Lord's day! Did you gather around the Lord's table last Lord's Day? If you did not, this is what you have done. You have broken fellowship with the Lord. Read 1 Corinthians 10:16 and in 2 Corinthians 6:14, we are warned not to forsake the communion with the Lord.

Another time we can meet with the Lord is when we sing praises unto him with our authorized instruments (the lips). Notice **Hebrews 13:15**, "By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name." Notice in Ephesians 5:19 and in Colossians 3:16, the Word teaches us of singing and making melody in the heart (mind) and singing with grace in our hearts to the Lord. Paul in **Acts 17:25**, says that "neither is worshipped with men's hands" such as statue buildings, organs, pianos, violins, etc. So, if you truly want to find the Lord, honor him with the proper obedience.

Last one, this time, because there are many others ways to find him, is when we truly, faithfully, honestly meet him with our financial obligations (1 Corinthians 16:1-2). Here is given the proper day, the correct amount (as you have been profited). Paul wrote in 2 Corinthians 9:7, says, "Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver." Notice in **Luke 6:38**, "Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again." So, we add, many have not, because they give not."

So, in closing, do you know how Jesus can be found? This we will note, he will find us at The Judgment, for we will all be there. 2 Corinthians 5:10 says so.

**Glen H. Watson, 95**



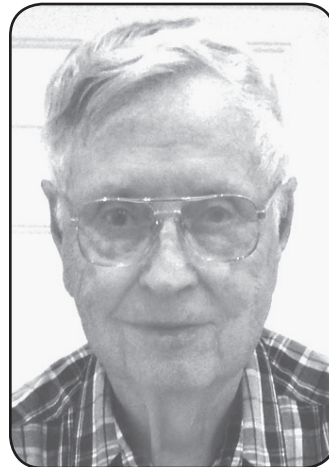
VETERAN

Glen Howard Watson, a recent resident of the Fountain Circle Care & Rehab Center in Winchester, Kentucky, died on Friday, February 22, 2019, at Clark Regional Medical Center, at the age of 95.

He was born one of eight children on February 3, 1924 at Cob Hill, Kentucky, to Herman and Lanie Watson. A United States Army veteran of World War II, he served with distinction in the 18th Division, 112th Infantry in Belgium, Germany, France, and England. He was a celebrated bluegrass musician who played the mandolin and wrote and recorded music with his first wife Vivian (deceased) and, most recently, with the Kentucky Cut-Ups.

Glen is preceded in death by both his parents; sisters, Orpha and Anna Lee; brothers, Otis and Dennis; second wife, Margaret; and his beloved third wife, Betty.

He is survived by sisters, Bea and Jewell; a brother, Audra; and by children, Glenda Parrillo, Nelda Marks, Ed Watson, and Ricky and Darrell Wasson; also grandchildren, Michelle, Cristina, and Michael; nine
