Indicators Within the Bible

As we begin this article, I want to say to our readers that we are grateful for the interest shown by many who say, we read your message each week in the paper. This is one of the ways we have to communicate the Gospel to some we have never met before. Also, we owe a great deal of gratitude to the owner of this paper for allowing us to come into your home each week. And, we also encourage all our readers to come and visit with us in person at any of our gatherings. **Now, to our subject today.**

Last week, we attempted to communicate to our readers that we believe that Jesus is soon coming again to judge the whole world. In **Romans 2:16, "In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel."** This is only one of many found in the New Testament, relating to the coming of Jesus.

But, even though no man know just when that day will come (See Matthew 24:42-44), still we are left many indicators within the Scriptures that will open our ears if we allow it to do so. For an example, a sign on the side of a highway may only have a crooked arrow upon it, without any wording; yet, this is an indicator that caution should be used when we approach this section of the road.

God in his Word has given us signs and indicators that something lies ahead, that we need to take caution and be watchful. For our learning, in 2 Timothy 3:1-5, here are several indicators that the Bible says that will point out to thinking minds some of the things that will be prevalent in the last days of this age.

First, allow me to inform our readers that this word here, last days, is a Greek word found only one

other place in the whole Bible. That means "the closing of the door upon this present time." Note: for a door to be open, only a crack is required for it to be deemed to be open. Personally, because of what is written here, and comparing them to world situations in men's lives, the crack is surely getting smaller.

Notice that he says, "perilous times shall come." Perilous means very dangerous. Surely we can look at the terrible things happening and also posed to happen; even within the nuclear threat that nations now have. One day, some fanatic will use one and off we go. Then Jesus tells us to love our neighbor, but at this time, there is much selfishness in the world. Only looking out for number one seems to be the norm of today. Coveting this world's goods is growing rapidly. "boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy." We have been living for several years over, within the lack of respect and honor among our youth relating to the parent.

He says, "without natural affection;" all types of sexual immorality is raging in this present world. He also mentions "incontinent," which means, I am not at fault because I am unable to cope with all the responsibilities of life. "Despisers of those that are good," then "lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God." Even among professed Christians, many will wrongly use the Lord's Day in pursuit of pleasure seeking.

"Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof;" never before in the history of our world has this been revealed more clearly. We are noted as a nation of church buildings, but all are teaching a plan different than what our Lord gave to save us. When men deviate in any form the plan of redemption, the name, the worship pattern, the work of the Lord's church, will they be saved? A careful reading of Matthew 7:21-23 will open eyes to many who read with a desire to know the truth. There is so much more that needs to be preached on this subject. 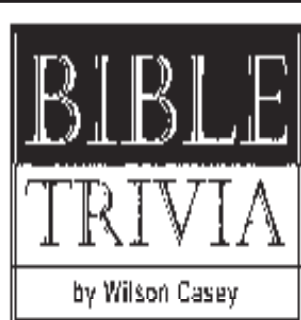

Recently there was an article tucked away in a newspaper about a young girl in Georgia who feels no pain. She suffers from a rare congenital disease that affects the nervous system. She and other individuals who are born with congenital insensitivity must be carefully guarded. They must be taught that fire burns or that if they fall a bone might be broken or if they are struck in the head it may result in a concussion. It is frightening to think of having to live with no warning system to alert us to pain or sickness. It requires them to be under constant surveillance for their own protection. There is another insensitivity, however, that is more serious - it is becoming insensitive to

sin. Our minds become numb to the dangers of sin as we see degrading pictures of people improperly exposing themselves to attract attention to their sensuality. Or the constant stories of the happiness and pleasures that come from drinking alcoholic beverages. Then there are the endless stories about children being born out of wedlock to famous Hollywood celebrities and attractive pictures of them being praised and celebrated. Children, not old enough to understand God's plan for marriage, are taught that it is appropriate for families to have two moms or two dads. What was once identified as wrong is now right.

But thank God that His Spirit is alive and anxious to convict hearts and change lives. "Deliver us and forgive us our sins for Your name's sake," said the psalmist. If we awaken to the danger of sin and confess, God will forgive us.
