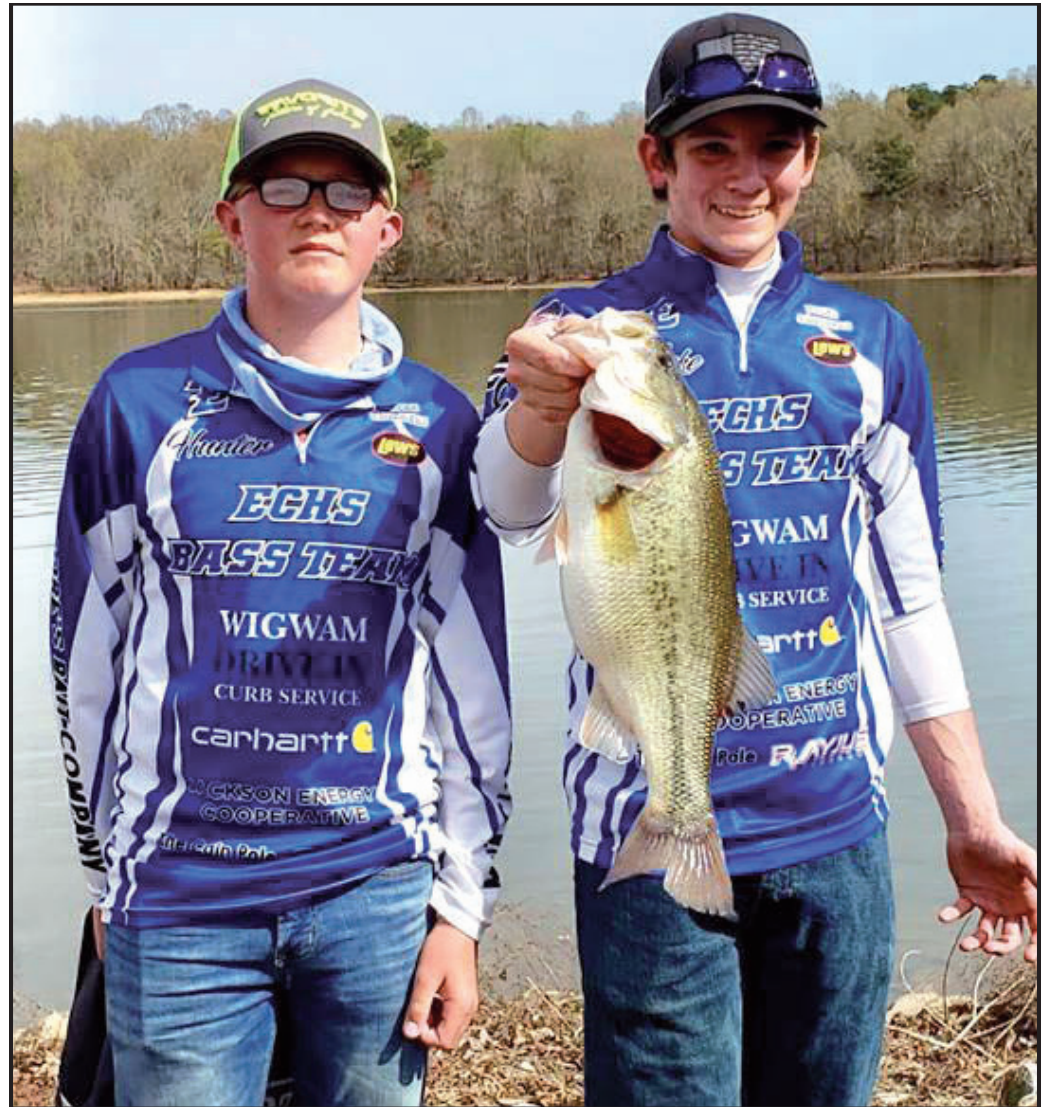


## Estill grad going to Nationals on Georgetown Fishing Team

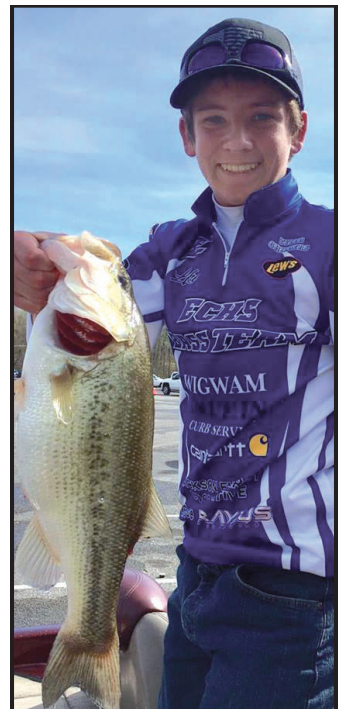
