

Day Camp at Aldersgate Church Camp

The United Methodist Churches of Estill County have teamed up with Aldersgate Camp to provide a one day Day Camp on Thursday, June 6.

Activities for the day will include Bible study, field games, craft project, swimming in the pool, visiting the farm animals, creek walk to the clay wall, and visiting and learning about the Fitchburg Furnace. The Day Camp staff will be the trained summer staff at Aldersgate Camp. Lunch and morning and afternoon snacks will be provided.

Limited transportation will be available at Irvine and Wisemantown United Methodist Churches. Pick-up will be at 9 a.m. and drop-off will be at 5 p.m.

Registration forms are available at the Estill County Public Library's bulletin board, the local United Methodist Churches, or at the Aldersgate Camp website: www.aldersgatecamp.org. The cost is \$15 to cover food and staff. A few scholarships will be available. Enrollment will be limited to the first 50 young people who register. Registration deadline will be Monday, June 3 at 5 p.m.

Those Under Indictment

I think that it is a sad thing for individuals to prolong the inevitable things that will come our way some time in our span of life. This is the first fact that we should come to grips with, and this is, not knowing the day of our death. Our cemetery stones bear witness to the fact that some only live one day; while others may have lived to be a hundred. But, as **1 Corinthians 15:22** says, "For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive." So, these two facts stated here are an ongoing process and will last until Jesus comes to raise the dead.

Sadly, many will push these facts to the rear of their minds, thinking, 'I know that I am going to die, but I have a lot of time left.' This is a deception of the devil. Did he not tell Mother Eve in the Garden that she would not surely die, but she did! Many of us have seen that death is coming to us all. Our own baby daughter only lived one day.
