

Estill Engineers Bass Teams finishes 4th Place in State Tournament

The Engineers Bass team traveled to Calvert City, Kentucky, on Kentucky Lake this past weekend for the KHSAA state championship. Two teams qualified for this event, Chase Rawlins and Micah Adams and Chris Wise and Lucas Puckett. There were 90 boats that qualified from across the state. This was a two day event where both days weights were combined.

Day one proved to be tough for Chris and Lucas; they were only able to put one keeper fish in the boat. Micah and Chase on the other hand got on some good fish and knew coming into weigh-in they had a shot to be leading this after day one. They weighed in 5 fish for a total weight 17.5 Lbs. That weight was good enough to put them in second place behind South Laurel High School after day one. South Laurel was in the lead with 19.9 Lbs.

On day two, with the weather changes, it

proved to be a tough day for the anglers but Chris and Lucas redeemed themselves with weighing in a 5-fish limit of 6.4 Lbs. Their weight wasn't enough to catch up.

Micah and Chase weighed in 5 fish with their weights dropping to 10.15 Lbs. Their over-all weights went down on day two. However, with a two-day combined weight of 27.12 Lbs., Micah and Chase were able to clinch the 4th place finish. South laurel held onto their lead to win the state tournament with a weight of 32.13 Lbs. Muhlenberg County finished second with 31.11 Lbs. and Ohio County got third with 28.10 Lbs.

The Engineers have had a great season making their presence known across the state on many different lakes and tournaments. With everybody coming back next year, this young team led by coach Chris Osborne has big goals coming up for next year's season.

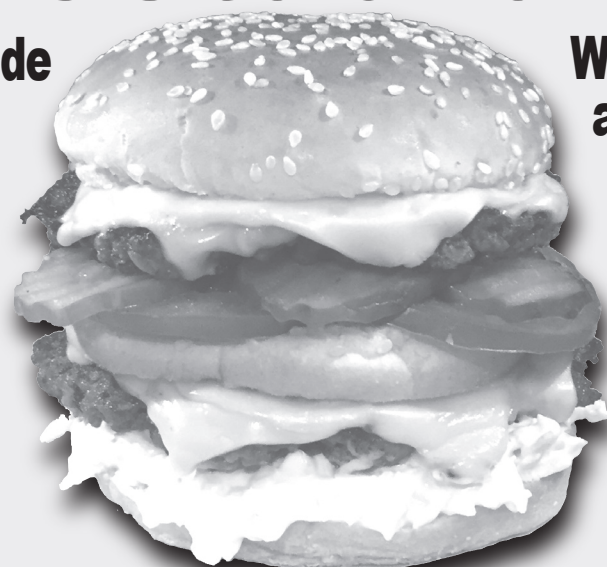
