Most of you know what the word 'indictment' means already, but to clarify this statement, it simple means, 'those who have been charged with a crime.' I ask, '<u>Can one be under an indictment, spiritually</u> <u>speaking</u>, even though he may not have broken any of man's laws regarding stealing, burglary, robbery, etc. The answer is, 'yes." In the Gospel of John, 3:18, it says, "He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is <u>condemned already</u>, begotten Son of God."

says John the Baptizer "was sent to bear witness of *that Light*" (Jesus) that all men through him might well. John 5:25 confirms that only the hearers shall <u>believe</u>. Therefore, the conclusion is very clear, any live. person that does not believe to the point of obedience is under the sentence of eternal destruction. trust, or what are you trusting in?
