Respect for Almighty God?

Let me announce this information as we begin. We are at present hosting a guest evangelist each month here at Cornerstone Church. This helps to keep the list of Bible sermons fresh and variable. Bro. Charlie Ward, a long-time preacher, will be speaking Sunday morning on the 12th of May if the Lord wills. You will profit by coming to hear him.

If you will notice, we are presenting a statement ending with a question mark. So, we are stating that at the present time, it does not appear that very many have much respect to Almighty God, nor to his Son, our only Saviour. Notice what the Bible says in **2 Corinthians 5:10-11**, "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad."

"¹¹Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences."

First, let me give my reasons for now believing that many do not have a respect for God. There is a consistent disregard for church attendance on the Lord's Day. Plus, many may come in later for only one hour of worship and disregard the Bible school or the Wednesday evening Bible study all together. Also, the vast majority of our citizens do not even use the Lord's Day except to recreate themselves in some way. Am I telling the truth?

I ask, do ye not fear God? Even the thief on the cross in **Luke 23:40** said to his likewise condemned friend, "Dost not thou fear God, seeing thou art in the same condemnation (of death)?"

I recall your attention to our opening Scripture

verses where it clearly states that all of us will make our own personal appearance before Jesus! But, most of men and women live just as it will never happen!

Do you ever wonder concerning the fear that must have finally persuaded the hearts of the unbelievers in Noah's day when upon ignoring God's warning, began to tread the water after the last mountain peak or the last tree limb went out of sight. How many fights broke out among them as they fought for life, but nothing came.

Do you know that there is a great piece of Scripture that appertains to the destruction of all who will not show respect toward God. Read this alarm! **Proverbs 1:24-28**. See for yourself. This may be the answer for our disregard of showing respect to God or Christ. "Because I have called, and ye refused; I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded; But ye have set at nought all my counsel, and would none of my reproof: I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your fear cometh; When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you. Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me:

"For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD: They would none of my counsel: they despised all my reproof. Therefore shall they eat of the fruit of their own way, and be filled with their own devices. For the turning away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them. But whoso hearkeneth unto me shall dwell safely, and shall be quiet from fear of evil." Jesus will say unto you, "Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire" (**Matthew 25:41**). This may fall hard upon your ears, but remember this, It doesn't have to. Only you can change the outcome.

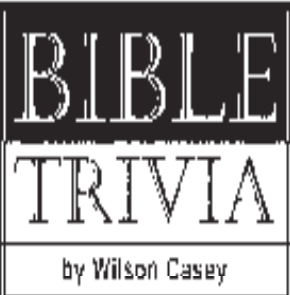
There was a need of superhuman strength to deliver man from his sins and his cursed life. There was no one to be found, either in earth below or Heaven above, equal to this task.
