The Motivation & Purpose of Gospel Preaching

A brother in Christ once said unto me, "I don't know why any man would choose to become a Gospel preacher!" Then, he went on to say why he would say such a thing. First, he said, the profits are nearly always insufficient toward his needed financial support, and he said, there is no retirement plan to help in his elderly years. And, besides these, most people do not appreciate his efforts because if any misunderstanding or some ruckus among the members occurs, they will ask for the preacher to resign and move on, putting the blame on his lack of leadership. So, I do not know why anyone would choose such a life.

At the remarks, I had to rethink all my intentions as a Gospel preacher from the very beginning. So, with gladness in my heart for his forgiveness and salvation, I know that I was not going to be one who would be content with just sitting on the sidelines. I wanted to show my Lord that I was willing to involve myself to whatever I could do to show my thanksgiving to him who saved me.

So, I went quickly to the rule book (the Bible) and for the first time, I had a burning desire to really know what it was all about. So, after a long year of constant study, I began to understand enough of its truth that I began to share it with others.

And, this is where the confusion began, because a lot of my encounters with supposed Christians revealed unto me that most know nothing but second-hand hearsay, parts of the Bible, and very little

of the complete context.

So, this is where I found myself. What could I do that might help inform and enlighten those who did not really know much about the Word of God. So, with a prayer on my lips and a desire in my heart, I began to try my hand at preaching. So, being motivated by **I Timothy 4:16**, "Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee." So, this has been the fuel that has kept my Gospel motor running since 1969 and this present day.

I still love the strength of the Gospel. I am always thrilled when someone responds and is baptized for the remission of their sins, because I remember what **Acts 2:47** says, that "the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved." So, I now know that my motivation is correct. I do have a place in God's scheme of redemption. I can never be an Apostle, which some liars claim, but I can follow their lead in the Lord's commission until then. So they obeyed and took the Gospel message into all the world. Mark 16:15-16 and Matthew 28:18-20 say that they did that, beginning at home.

One closing point, the Apostles did not change the message one iota. Neither should any preacher today. But sadly, many have tried and are still trying to do so today. So, what will be the outcome of all such? So, we close with this warning from the Lord, **Revelation 21:7-8**, "He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. ⁸But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death." Fearful? You bet! So don't put your hope upon any thing but what the Bible says for your redemption.

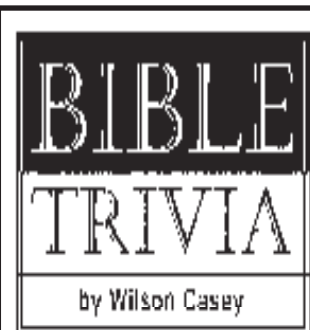
