



Jesus came into the world to seek and to save that which was lost. His mission of love and compassion brought cleansing to the lepers and sight to the blind. His goodness, love and mercy was freely showered upon all who He met. He came to draw all men unto himself, yet "He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not." — Isaiah 53: 3 (KJV)

The greatest suffering of Our Lord was not the not the physical punishment He bore in the hands of angry sinners. It was the heartbreak caused by the rejection of his offer of life to His own people. The prophetic voice of Isaiah was true, "we esteemed him not." There is no greater sorrow and suffering than that of the heartbreak of being spurned and rejected by those whom a person loves. Jesus suffered this rejection. "He came unto his own, and his own received him not." — John 1: 11 (KJV)

The great sorrow and heartbreak of our Lord, was freely expressed by the tears that flowed down His cheeks as He stood and wept over the city of Jerusalem. Prophetically, he saw the city in ruins and the people slaughtered and scattered.

Luke 19:41-42 (KJV), "And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it ⁴² Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes."

He was forsaken by the fickle multitude. The very people he had fed, healed and blessed. These were the people he deeply loved and trusted who would cling to Him. The agony of His soul caused Him to weep unashamedly over a hard-hearted people who failed to appreciate His offer of love. They were guilty of ingratitude of the lowest sort.

Israel failed to recognize the mission of our Lord, and spurned his offer of a king and a kingdom. They despised Him who knew no sin and unashamedly cried, "away with Him." But they cried out, Away with him, away with

him, crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar." — John 19: 15 (KJV)
