Each luminaria represents the life of someone who has battled cancer. It is a

beautiful, moving sight when all the bags with candles are illuminated around the track to remember loved ones lost to cancer and to pay tribute to cancer survivors.

Since its beginning in 1985, Relay for Life has developed from one man running around a track of 24 hours to a full-fledged international event, which takes place in more than 5,000 communities and 20 countries, with nearly 4 million walkers in the U.S. alone.

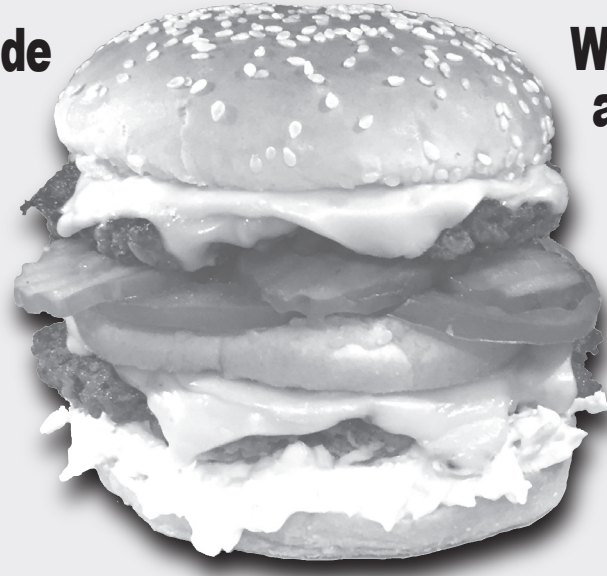
