Harold Wiseman, 86



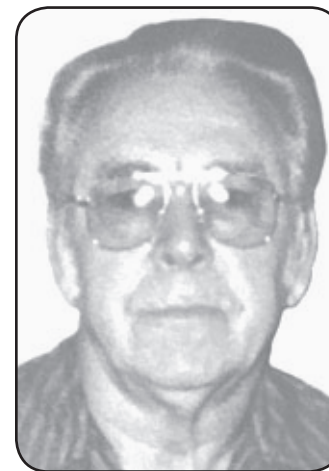
