why Philip preached this? Because this is what Jesus said in **Matthew 10:32**, "Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven." Then, to fulfill the requirements to meet Jesus and to solidify or confirm one's faith, baptism, all the way under water, for the remission of sin must be obeyed. See Matthew 25:15-20, Mark 16:15-16, Acts 2:38, Romans 6:3-5. And, yes, the eunuch obeyed the Gospel in Acts 8:38, and the results were, he met Jesus on his terms and his heart was rejoicing.

Now, when we sing a hymn like *Amazing Grace*, there is a verse in 2 that is not according to the truth, because it says, "How precious did, That grace appear, The hour I first believed." Now, this is not the message we have just read in the New Testament. Men are not saved by belief alone, or at the moment one may believe; as some would have you and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace to believe. Notice in James 2:19, "... the devils also believe, and tremble." And in Mark 16:15-16, Jesus in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, said, "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. ¹⁶He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved ..."
