### Summer Reading Wrap-Up

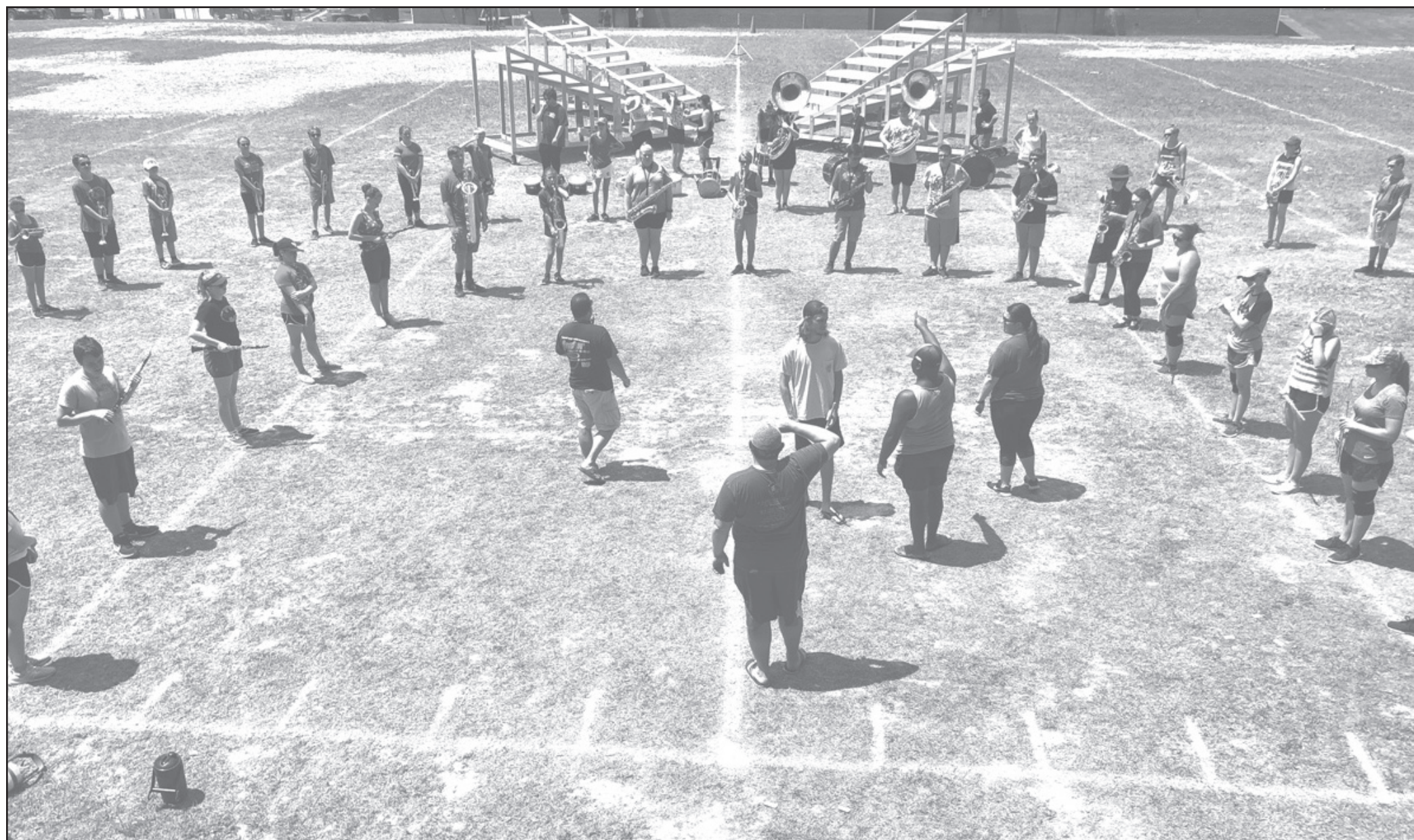

I'm sorry to cut this article short. With all the end of summer tasks I fell behind with writing. I will be sharing a lot more in next week's article so make sure you check it out!



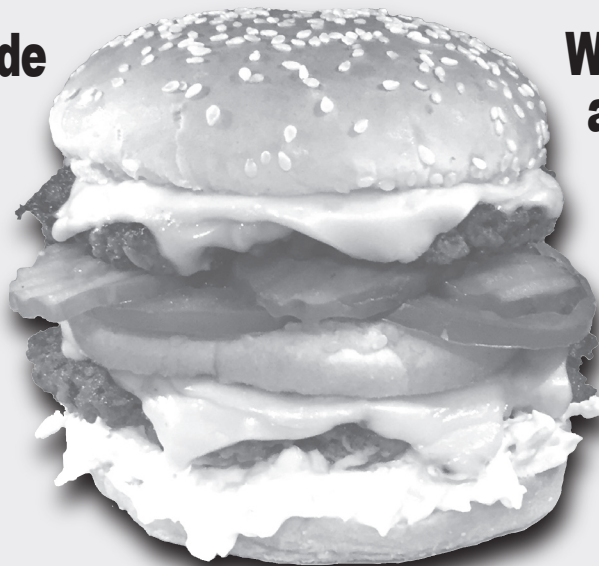
