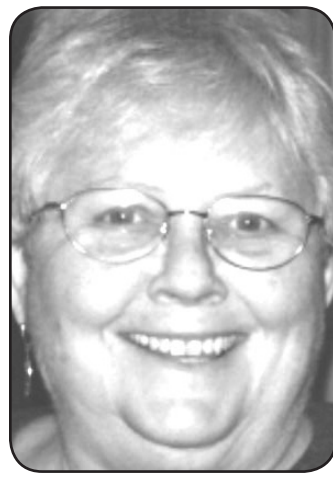
Judy Ann Causey, 74
